## Perspex® Cast Acrylic

**D**esign Project produced this unique slipcase from Fluorescent Perspex® sheets.

With a brief to create a Corporate Workspace branded box to hold sales literature, the intention was for clients to keep the product and critically, its contents on record.

With Perspex® Fluorescent being used, the lid was engineered to hide all fixing detail and create a more simple aesthetic. While the final design appears simple and effortless, in fact it involved a great deal of prototyping, to ensure a perfect fit, and encompassed many different fabrication and machining processes.

Perspex® Fluorescent had previously been used for the company's business cards which were

laser etched for the extreme accuracy and detail that the process provided. Having also worked so well to accentuate the Corporate Workspace brand, it was an obvious choice of material and process to use once again.

Routed features and holes then enabled the mounting of the lid on to the top of the box and provided a finger pull to open the case.

The lid was then softened along a bend line using a strip heater and was bent at 90° to form a fold over lip.
